### Rob Powell (President)

#### Emailed before the meeting:

- There's a meeting with MLC Land and a bunch of resident volunteers on July 10th to discuss the Allard HOA starting up in the fall. Rob Powel will be there as both a league representative and Allard resident. He has invited the President of the Blackburne HOA to come as well for advice/experience.
- Rob Powell got a couple volunteers to update the road sign on James Mowatt Trail by Roberta MacAdams School.
- The bookkeeper has started the process of trying to claim the \$5,000 earmarked for us by South-West Area Council (SWAC) for volunteers from our league working their last casino. That will go straight into our casino account and can be used for things like projects or running the rink.
- The community league membership to the Edmonton Tool Library was renewed so that league members can use it for free for another year.
- A mini crisis with AGLC was averted by submitting some raffle paperwork for the Callaghan Playground committee that was a year overdue. Our previous Treasurer forgot to send it in, probably due the massive amount of soccer related work at the time.

- A potential location for x-country ski trails near the creek was submitted to the City for review. SWAC would lay the tracks for free. It's a nice big flat area with trees in Cavanagh. It might be developer owned land but they aren't building on it yet. We'll see what happens.
- Our outdoor movie night is booked for September 14th.
